

INTENTIONAL FAITH DEVELOPMENT WEEKLY OPPORTUNITIES - ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

Cornerstone Class - Meets in Youth Activity Center

For men and women of all ages. Provides a non-intimidating yet structured environment to gain a new understanding of how the Old Testament supplies the firm foundation for the New Testament. A chronological study through the high points of the Bible.

Genesis Class - Meets in Room 111 (The Cry Room)

For men and women of various ages with young children looking to connect with other parents. The class format varies. Study topics are relevant to current events and current class interest.

Fidellis Class - Meets in the Parlor

For men and women ages 55-70. The Bible is studied using a discussion format.

New Beginnings Class - Meets in Room 112

For empty - nest adults of all ages. The class is led by rotating teachers.

New Life Class - Meets in the Chapel

For adults in upper 30's - 40+, married and singles, most have school aged children. Various topics are taught by rotating teachers.

Open Door Class - Meets in Room 101 (The Bride's Room)

For men and women who desire an in-depth Bible study. This group is studying the Bible from Genesis to Revelation. Class members read outside of class and discuss the reading on Sunday mornings. Leadership is shared by members.

Singles and Friends - Meets in Room 102

For single or married adults age 40+. Class discussion study format includes various themes ranging from 6-8 weeks of Bible study, historical/cultural background on the Bible, social issues, and comparative religions.

Wesley Class - Meets in Room 106 & 108

For senior adults - 55+. The class has a rotation of teachers that study the Bible verse by verse, book by book.
